

PETROLEUM FACTS AT A GLANCE – JULY 2018 release

1. Total U.S. supply of crude oil, natural gas liquids and other liquids in July 2018: 16,345,000 b/d, up by 2,146,000 b/d in the past year (July 2017: 14,199,000 b/d) [API]
2. Record-tying U.S. crude oil production in July 2018: 10,717,000 b/d (of which 379,000 b/d was Alaskan) (July 2017: 9,238,000 b/d). Record U.S. production of natural gas liquids in July 2018: 4,364,000 b/d (July 2017: 3,755,000 b/d). [API]
3. Total petroleum products delivered to the domestic market in July 2018: 20,586,000 b/d (July 2017: 20,020,000 b/d). [API]
4. Total July petroleum exports: 7,071,000 b/d (July 2017: 6,232,000 b/d). [API]
5. U.S. petroleum trade balance fell by 154,000 b/d to 3,464,000 b/d in July 2018 from 3,618,000 b/d in July 2017. [API]
